Heritage Elementary: Response to Intervention (RTI)

At Heritage our goal is to have all students performing academically at or above grade level. Teachers constantly monitor student progress toward grade level goals. If a student falls below grade level, interventions are in place to give extra instruction, time,

and support. Our interventions fall into three tiers:

Tier I—Regular classroom instruction provided to all students

Tier 2—Supplemental small group instruction

Tier 3—Intense individual or targeted small group instruction

- Small group math instruction for students in second through fifth grade
- I- Ready, a computer based literacy and math program that provides individualized pacing
- Imagine Learning, a computer based language and literacy program
