Information:

We had a magic show on Tuesday and learned that **not** everything is what it appears to be online. There are many people who try to trick us into sharing personal information or into seeing things that make us feel embarrassed or uncomfortable. Today we talked more about this. There are some people who use the internet to hurt other people. Some websites look safe that are not. Some people seem safe, but they're not. We should never download anything unless we ask a trusted adult. And we should never share personal information with someone online. It's dangerous!
